To commemorate the great trainer and educator of generations of boxers, the Polish Boxing Association decided to establish an international tournament named after him. The first in the series took place in November 1977. For many years it was one of the most important Olympic boxing events.

We warmly invite all federations affiliated with World Boxing, to take part in this exceptional event. The "World Boxing Cup: Feliks Stamm - Poland 2025" - 40th Jubilee International Boxing Tournament in Honor of Feliks Stamm is a true celebration of Olympic boxing.

## 2. COMPETITION RULES & FORMAT

This event will be conducted in accordance with the World Boxing Competition Rules.

Age category	Elite, born from 1 January 1985 to 31 December 2006
Men's weight categories	47-50 Kg; 50-55 Kg; 55-60 Kg; 60-65 Kg; 65-70 Kg; 70-75 Kg; 75-80 Kg; 80-85kg; 85-90 Kg; Plus 90 Kg
Women's weight categories	45-48 Kg; 48-51 Kg; 51-54 Kg; 54-57 Kg; 57-60 Kg; 60-65 Kg; 65-70 Kg; 70-75 Kg; 75-80 Kg; Plus 80 Kg
Draw sizes and composition	Max 32 boxers per weight category. Max 2 boxers from NF per weight category.
Entries acceptance criteria	The World Boxing Cup: Poland 2025 is an open-entry competition, with participation determined by the following priorities. The first priority is given to the winners of the 2023 and 2024 World Boxing Cup stages, as well as the Paris 2024 Medalists. To ensure transparency, Final Entry Lists will be circulated to all participating teams, keeping everyone informed of potential draw cut-offs. Withdrawals, including late withdrawals will be managed in accordance with Article 5 of the Competition Rules.
Ranking points	There will be no ranking points awarded for this Boxing World Cup.
Number of rings	One or Two dependent on entry. If two rings required for Preliminary rounds the event will transition to one ring for semifinals and finals
Scoring and timing	Swiss Timing
Boxing equipment	Sting
Hand wrapping	Pro bandaging tape and gauze, provided by LOC
Technical Officials	World Boxing & PBA certified
Sport Entries Check	Mandatory for inclusion into the draw, appointment set prior to arrival

## 4. ENTRY PROCESS

It is required that respective participating National Federations confirm the technical and medical standard of the boxers and other Team Members. Participating National Federations are also responsible for submitting the personal data on behalf of each member of their Team, and for ensuring that the personal information provided during the entry process is accurate.

At this time, the entry process for Teams is completed via email, as specified in the table below:

Registering reserve boxers is strongly encouraged to allow for substitutions after the entry deadline prior to the Sport Entries Check without penalties.

Bringing a World Boxing certified Referee and Judge to the competition is highly encouraged. Referee and Judges are subject to confirmation by World Boxing, and ultimately, the National Federation may be asked to replace the proposed R&J.

Withdrawals after the final entry deadline will not be refunded.

It is the responsibility of participating National Federations to ensure that all Team Members are qualified to perform their duties.

#### 4.1. Sport Entries Check

The Sport Entries check is the final part of the event entry process and it will take place on 11<sup>th</sup> May, time and location TBC. World Boxing and the LOC will inform Teams of their exact appointment time prior to the event as well as it will be displayed on the Team information board.

**The Sport Entries Check is mandatory for all Teams, and teams should make all necessary arrangements to arrive timely for their respective appointment.**

Each Team may appoint a maximum of two people to attend its Sport Entries check (e.g. Team Manager and the Team Doctor).

In order to be cleared for the competition, Teams must provide the following documents for each boxer, signed and completed as required:

- Copy of passport
- Record Book (with annual medical examination completed within the previous 12 months)
- Medical Certificate issued within the previous three months, signed by the National Federation doctor
- Declaration of Non-Pregnancy Form (women boxers only), signed by the boxer/legal guardian
- Uniforms (red and blue) per World Boxing Competition Rules

**To complete the Sport Entries process and receive accreditations, Teams must have fully settled their accommodation costs with the LOC.**

**Important: Failure to attend the Sport Entries Check per scheduled appointment by any Team will lead to the exclusion of the entire Team from taking part in the event.**



## 5. VISA & ENTRY TO THE HOST COUNTRY

LOC will provide assistance to participating Teams requiring Visas but cannot guarantee their acquisition.

Those countries that need visas for Poland need to register a visa application in the e-consulate system. To receive a visa to participate in sports events, teams will need an invitation from the host organization.

**The deadline to submit requests for visa support letters is 2 May 2025.**

Passports of all Championships participants must be valid for at least six months from the date of arrival and must contain blank page(s) for visa(s) and stamps.

It is the responsibility of participating National Federations to ensure that their Team respect the conditions of stay defined by the Government of the country hosting the event. If any participant does not respect these conditions, any costs arising will be borne by the respective National Federation.

## 7. GROUND TRANSPORTATION

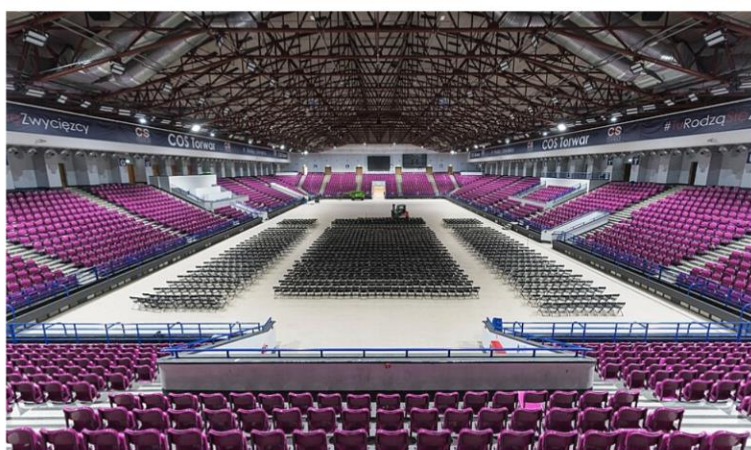

## 10. IMAGE RIGHTS & VIDEO RECORDING

The LOC will film the event for broadcast, promotional videos and official event photographers will take still images of boxers before and during the event. All training sessions will be open to the accredited media unless a Team specifically requests otherwise. By participating in the event, each Team Member agrees to release his/her image rights to World Boxing and the LOC.

Video recording of bouts for broadcasting purposes of any kind (including social media) will not be allowed.

National Federations may be allowed to record bouts of their boxers using only one camera per ring, exclusively for technical purposes. Specific location in the venue will be reserved for this purpose. Each National Federation must submit a signed copy of Video Recording Disclaimer at the Technical Meeting to World Boxing Competition Manager.

## 11. MEDICAL SERVICES

The LOC will provide first aid during the entire event period to any participant who suffers from a sports injury contracted during the event.

## 12. ANTI-DOPING

Doping control will be conducted in accordance with World Boxing Anti-Doping Rules and World Anti-Doping Code. According to WADA regulations, blood testing may be conducted during World Boxing Competitions.

## 13. INSURANCE

All accredited participants must have their own travel, medical, repatriation and liability insurance covering the entire event and travel period.

## 14. PRACTICAL INFO

**Language:** The official language is Polish.

**Currency:** The currency is the zloty (PLN).

**Time zone:** Poland in summer is in the CET (UTC+2) time zone.

**Tourism:** Poland is known for its cuisine, historic sites, natural landscapes, and cultural artifacts.

**Weather:** In May, Poland is usually warm and dry. The average daytime temperature in Warsaw, Poland in May is 19°C (66°F) and the average nighttime temperature is 9°C

**Emergency Number:** In the event of an emergency you should call the free emergency number 112, which is operated in both Polish and English.

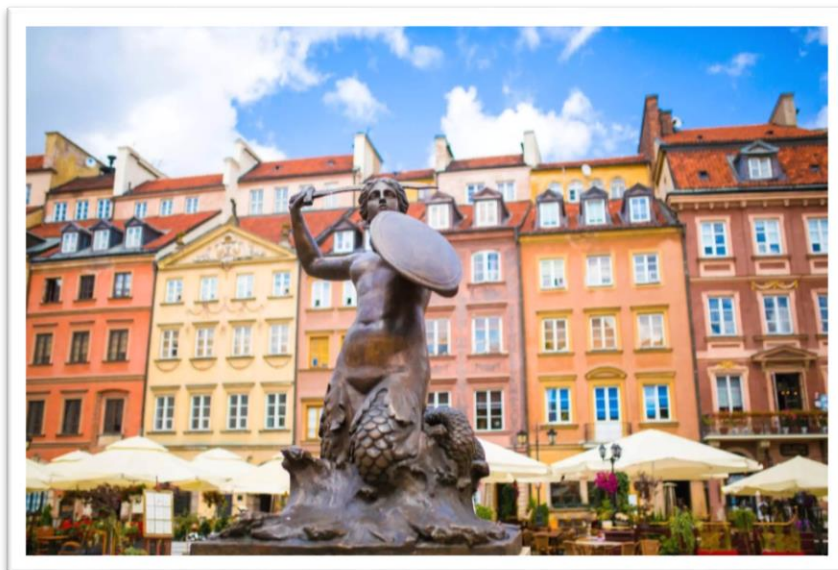
### **Warsaw – General information**

Warsaw has been the capital of Poland since 1596.

**Population:** 1,799,000

The Old Town was destroyed in 1944 but was later reconstructed and is a UNESCO World Heritage site.

Warsaw has a wide variety of museums, galleries, and other tourist attractions.



The Mermaid of Warsaw (Polish: Syrenka Warszawska) is a symbol of Warsaw, represented on the city's coat of arms as well as in a number of statues and other imagery.





**Warsaw Old Town.** It is the oldest portion of the city, and contains numerous historic buildings, mostly from 17th and 18th centuries, such as the Royal Castle, city walls, St. John's Cathedral, and the Barbican, the Old Town Market Square and the Warsaw Mermaid Statue.

**Palace of Culture and Science.** One of the highest and most magnificent buildings in Warsaw. Its majestic tower is visible from almost all places in the city.



**Royal Baths or Łazienki Królewskie** is the largest park in the centre of Warsaw. On the area of 76 hectares one may find over 40 points of interest and numerous historic buildings, designed by the king Stanisław August Poniatowski's in-court architects. Palace on the Isle, Roman Theatre, Myśliwiecki Palace or Chopin Monument are just a small selection.
